Reviewing the docket on PACER to keep up with filings and managing the responses for each action is time consuming for even the most organized trustees office. How It Works

TrusteSolutions downloads the docket from PACER so that trustees can review cases and associated ECF documents in TrusteSolutions' user friendly interface. TrusteSolutions Docket Parser removes the manual labor in reviewing docket entries. As an example, consider a debtor's address change docket entry. When the debtor files a change of address with the court, trustees will receive a PDF notice of the filing via email. TES' Docket Parser Customization Service can be set to automatically create an entry on the user's task list. To get an idea of how users take advantage of docket parser, the following are a few examples of how Docket Parser can help a Trustee's office.

Updating case date, such as, Claims bar dates, final decree dates and TDR filed at court. The case status can be updated when a TDR is or a TFR is filed at court. Court Order dates are entered into a case when the order for the TFR is approved. When an adversary case is filed, a custom date can be entered and a task created. Clerk's Certification and Intent to File TFR can also update tasks and dates.

All of these examples would need the Trustee's office to manually review hundreds of dockets. Using TES Docket Parser Customer Service, these updates occur without user intervention based on rules/instructions provided by the trustee's office.
